Bacon Cheddar Biscuits Recipe

- 2 1/4 cups flour
- 3 3/4 Tsp. baking powder
- 1 Tsp. salt
- 1/8 Tsp. ground red pepper
- 1/2 cup diced slab bacon (about 3 oz.)
- 3 TBSP butter, cubed and chilled
- 3/4 cup shredded sharp cheddar cheese (about 3 oz.)
- 1 1/2 cups heavy cream 2 TBSP butter, melted
- 1. Combine flour and next 3 ingredients; cover and freeze 8 hr.

- 2. Preheat oven to 425°. Cook bacon over medium-low heat about 6 min. or until bacon is brown but not crisp; drain on paper towels. Cool completely.
- 3. Toss cubed butter with flour mixture in a large bowl; mix with hands, flattening butter until mixture resembles coarse crumbs. Stir in cheese and bacon. Add cream; stir until just combined. Scoop dough evenly into 1 TBSP mounds; arrange 1" apart on baking sheets.
- 4. Bake 8-10 minutes or until golden and cooked through. Transfer biscuits to a wire rack and brush with melted butter. Best served warm.


